Since 2015, more than 200 people have participated in the Liberatus mission to inspire American unity. Thank you! The Liberatus community represents the full range of political perspectives and includes both Americans with professional experience in politics and supporters scattered across 20 states.

While the way we have worded our vision has evolved from healing through freedom, to wholeness in politics, to American unity, our approach has always been to grow through personal connections and relationships. National healing or unity is by nature relational, not a marketing campaign or top-down directive.

We believe the American idea is this: we can establish justice and secure freedom when we collaborate and build trust. Collaboration and trust happen when we choose unity and commit to the long journey.

While many of us grew up inspired by The Greatest Generation, we feel powerless to move the country in the right direction. Division, noise, and choosing against our fellow Americans often seem to be the only ways to participate in self-governance—including in Christian communities.

But unity is America's first founding ideal, going all the way back to the "Join, or Die" cartoon published by Benjamin Franklin in 1754. And unity was the prayer of Jesus for the body of Christ before he was betrayed. The mission of Liberatus is a beautiful and direct response to division, abuses of power, and rejection of who we can become in Christ by leaders in the Church, in politics, and in our own lives.

We all want leaders who make our country stronger. And we want our voices and values to guide them.

What our stakeholders have created so far is a foundational, transformative, and monumental new way to approach American self-governance.

Liberatus offers inspiration for American unity to help you choose unity, build endurance, and become the leaders who make our country more just and free for the next generation.

Out of the conversation, deeper reading, and writing that produced the 122 digital journal entries across eighteen creative themes in the Liberatus journal archive, we discovered three actions that we can take to choose unity:

- 1. Be inclusive.
- 2. Stay grounded in wisdom.
- 3. Create!

We believe anyone can take these actions at any time, and in many contexts. We believe that they represent the nature of God and reflect the way God relates to us: as children of God, we can be led by the Spirit of God to live creative lives of restoration. Therefore the problem with division isn't that it's not nice; it's that it's not true. Humanity's full story arc from a Christian perspective begins in original goodness and ends in restoration. As American citizens and as people of faith, that's the story that we get to not only tell in political communication, but also live. When we do so beautifully over time, despite setbacks, we learn to master a build endurance mindset and demonstrate the meaning of hope.

If you've ever felt that American politics is dysfunctional and wanted to tune it out, imagine what it feels like to work in politics professionally when the stated values—including among people of faith—is to divide, sideline other Americans, and communicate ideas that we know are only half true.

Liberatus is their platform to craft a new ethos of unity and peace.

We connect with our fellow Americans in real life, create work that lives up to our shared values, and inspire them for their journey to become leaders for American unity. And we self-evaluate continually to be sure that this statement is true.

To grow, developing or strengthening leaders for American unity is the core of what we will do. We can build a sustainable organization by connecting with other Americans, and we can connect with Americans by building a team of leaders. We anticipate that leaders who work with us from creators to ambassadors will go on to lead for American unity in other roles in the future.

In the pursuit of collaboration and building trust, we are also actively pursuing conversations with the leaders of other organizations to develop more partnerships. There are many brands working in various ways to heal our country's divides, and the more creative options Americans have to get involved, the more likely they will be to find one that fits their style, and the stronger our country will be.

40 years from now, inspiration for American unity through a biannual journal means we will have leaders for American unity. Our kids, grandkids, nieces, and nephews will grow up knowing how to pursue wisdom in self-governance; in Christian circles this has not been well taught or understood.



WAYS TO SHARE THE MISSION

Build Endurance by Funding the Team

As we work toward the larger goal of biannual publication, we've set an end of year or short-term goal of raising \$3,000 to fund final editing and publishing of over 100 letters on leadership as part of onboarding new leaders.

To reach biannual publication, we will need \$200,000 per year for five consecutive years. We can scale and build the Liberatus community by developing leaders on our team and across the country who join us as Ambassadors (field reps), and through partnerships with other organizations to distribute copies. Major investments over five years will allow us to reach the larger goal of biannual publication.
